WHAT AND WHO

OBJECTIVES

The International Federation of Scholarly Associations of Management shall promote the development of management research and teaching as a **unified science** and its advancement in all nations of the world. Means to this shall include :

- organizing international conferences ;
- eventually publishing a journal of management research that includes contributions from around the world ;
- providing other means for the exchange of information on management research and teaching among associations of scholars throughout the world ;
- encouraging the establishment of national associations of scholars of management.

IFSAM was founded in June 1990 in Frankfurt (Germany) with a strong support from the Japan Society of Business Administration and the Verband der Hochschullehrer für Betriebswirtschaft from Germany.

MEMBERSHIP

IFSAM is mainly an umbrella organization. The membership of IFSAM consists of established management associations of scholars whose primary interests are to advance management research and teaching. IFSAM is a federation of organizations formed to link these associations and bolster their aims. Individuals are not normally accepted for membership. However, in order to stimulate the establishment of national associations of scholars of management where none exists, individuals may be accepted as temporary members.
